

SUMMER OPPORTUNITIES (Online and Other Ideas)

This is not a comprehensive list, but will give you ideas to get you thinking about what you can do this summer. You can think about opportunities in 6 categories:

- Family
 - Taking care of siblings.
 - Helping older relatives
 - etc.
- Work
 - Traditional jobs – Grocery store, restaurant, bakery, marina, garden store, ice cream shop, etc.
 - Teaching online – Tutoring for middle or elementary school, dance, chess, art, etc.
- Community Service
 - Think about needs in your community
 - Think about groups that need help now – Seniors, people with disabilities, underserved kids and adults, etc.
 - Examples: Food drives, helping with deliveries, helping seniors with technology, writing letters to healthcare workers or seniors, etc.
- Enrichment
 - Online classes in new or current interest – Free online classes, summer college programs (Some have reduced tuition for online)
 - Develop skill – e.g., Coding
 - Research – Online programs, ask high school teachers if they have a project
 - Your own projects – e.g., Book Club, cooking, art projects, make a film, creative writing, learn an instrument, etc.
- School Groups – Continue activity into summer (e.g., A cappella, school newspaper online, etc.)
- Athletics – Stay engaged with your team (e.g., Organize workouts/drills or team community service projects, etc.)
- Politics – Volunteer for campaign or elected official (Youth advisory group, phone banking, research, communications).
